Elix Advantage Scholarship

The Elix Advantage Scholarship is made possible through the generous philanthropic support of Mr Doug Elix AO (DAC 1966) and Mrs Robin Elix.

Doug Elix attended St Peter's College from 1958 to 1966 and served as a School Prefect and House Captain. He has lived and worked in Australia and the USA and retired from his position of Senior Vice President and Group Executive at IBM in July 2008.

In 2006, Doug was awarded the rank of Officer of the Order of Australia for service to the information technology and services industry internationally, to the business sector through facilitating the introduction of world's best technology in many companies, and as a mentor to industry professionals.

Doug is passionate about providing an opportunity to a student who adds to the diversity of the student community at St Peter's College that is indicative of the wider world.

Selection Criteria

The Elix Advantage Scholarship will be awarded to a student not currently enrolled at the School and who possesses all-round qualities and can provide evidence of the following:

- Record of strong academic endeavours.
- Evidence of service and/or citizenship in current school community and beyond.
- High level of participation in co-curricular activities (Music, Sport, Drama, Visual Arts etc).
- High level of engagement at current school.

The scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding student who would be unable to attend St Peter's College without financial support.

Benefits

The Elix Advantage Scholarship includes:

- Remission of 50% to 100% of tuition fees, IT levy and fixed charges for the duration of the scholarship based on means testing.
- A 100% remission of application and enrolment fees normally payable once a formal offer of admission to St Peter's College has been made (value of \$2,700).

An additional grant to cover a proportion of the initial start-up costs may be given, including:

- School uniform (up to \$1,750).
- Books and stationery (up to \$500) in the first year only.
- MacBook, required by all students (up to \$2,500).

Expectations

The family will be expected to participate in the School community, attending School activities and events (particularly in relation to their son's activities) and in School community groups.

The scholarship recipient's family is encouraged to make a financial contribution to the Foundation, for the duration of the scholarship and beyond. Such support will assist the Foundation to provide similar opportunities for other students in the future.

The recipient will be expected to provide feedback to the Foundation about the impact of the scholarship on a regular basis during his schooling and, from time to time, as an old scholar. The family will be invited to participate in occasional events and activities that recognise and give thanks to the community of donors.

Checklist

For the student to be considered for a scholarship, please ensure all the requested documents are supplied.

A covering letter written by the student, addressing the selection criteria and detailing his reasons for seeking the Elix Advantage Scholarship.

A covering letter from the student's Parents/Guardians, detailing their reasons for seeking the Elix Advantage Scholarship.

A recent photo of the student.

A copy of the student's most recent school reports for 2024.

Copies of the student's last two NAPLAN results from Years 7 and 9.

At least one letter of reference with a daytime telephone contact commenting on the student's personal attributes and character (ideally provided by a teacher or someone who is unrelated to the student and has known the student for many years).

A copy of Australian Taxation Office (ATO) business and personal statements for the past three financial years. Information must include declarations on income, expenses, financial assets and liabilities as well as benefits or assistance received.

Completed financial statement outlining full list of assets and liabilities.

A separate sheet identifying areas of strength and excellence and listing the student's interests and involvement in sport, music, church, community and other activities.

Copies of any awards or certificates the student has received for academic, sporting, music, artistic, community or character achievements.

Please confirm you meet the prerequisites for consideration for this scholarship opportunity:

The applicant is an Australian Citizen and/or Permanent Resident and is currently attending a school other than St Peter's College.

The student will be in Year 10 in 2026 and be a day or boarding student. Please note this scholarship does not provide remission of boarding fees.

We understand this scholarship is subject to means-testing and the relevant documents have been provided.

We understand the scholarship will cover 50% to 100% of tuition fees, IT levy and fixed charges based on means testing.
